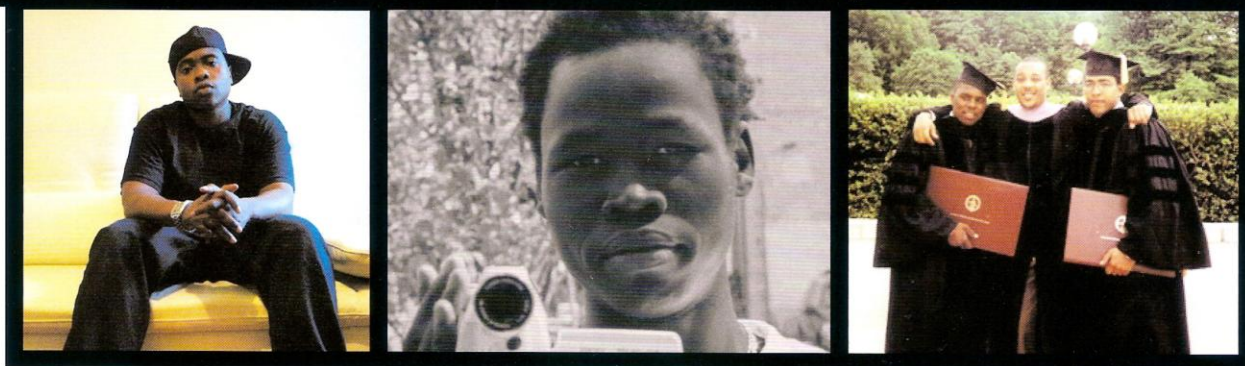

What does it mean to be a man? The Masculinity Project gathers multi-generational voices to explore this question, with a focus on the black community in the 21st century. Using stories, interviews and visual essays by and about black men and boys, the project reveals the many definitions of manhood in the African American community.

New and veteran producers alike will create a dynamic online forum that combines video, podcasts, blogs, audio clips and user-generated content. Newly completed video work will stream online alongside excerpts from existing films. The goal: to create an interactive discourse about masculinity in the black community, using the full range of available technologies and engaging a broad, diverse audience.
